The Criminological Information Service (Fachinformationsdienst Kriminologie, FID) is mainly focused on the task to provide the scientific community with literature and other subject-relevant information on criminology as comprehensively as possible.

Currently, around

- 125,000 monographs
- 240 active journal subscriptions
- 320 digital documents in <u>DigiKrimDoc</u> as well as
- 1,500 digital documents in the criminological <u>repository</u>

are part of the FID.

2) The most important research tool for the literature inventory as well as for bibliographical references, is the KrimDok database.

In this database are currently (status: July 2021) about 265,600 references.
