It's a fixed-term contract for 30 months, at 0.6 FTE.

This is an exciting opportunity for a Post-Doctoral Researcher to be part of a research team at the University of Warwick's Criminal Justice Centre (CJC) and Law School (WLS). This position is available on a Leverhulme Trust Research Project titled: 'The Vulnerable State: Appraising the Ambivalent Economies of State Power'. We are seeking candidates with a PhD, or if close to submission, the role would begin as a grade 5 Research Assistant, with promotion to grade 6 upon conferral of the PhD award.

We are seeking research expertise in Law, Sociology, Anthropology, Politics, or Criminology, which are disciplines covered by the project.
